Timing: 2026

STAGE 1A:

Pavilion, carpark, and associated access road.

Timing: 2030

Works will not be delivered at time of commencement of use for Eastern Short Course.

STAGE 4:

Future eastern land expansion golf adjacent facilities including additional carpark and driving range.

Timing: Beyond 2030

Works will not be delivered at time of commencement of use for Eastern Short Course.
