Development details

The proposed development involves the duplication of Shute Harbour Road, between Paluma Road to Tropic Road, to provide two traffic lanes in both directions. The project includes:

- Proposed construction of two dual-lane roundabouts, at William Murray Drive and MacArthur Drive, and a possible third roundabout at Valley Drive
- Reconfiguration of all other accesses and intersections in between William Murray Drive and MacArthur Drive
- Widening of existing pavement and culverts along the lanes of the project
- Widening of culvert at Waite Creek.
