Arrow is withdrawing the LPH RIDA application as the activity can be undertaken via the Section 22 exemption.

Arrow is withdrawing this application because:

- voluntary agreements (Conduct and Compensation Agreements) have been reached with all landowners subject to the LPH RIDA application; and
- the activity is not likely to have a significant impact on the priority agricultural area or area that is in the strategic cropping area nor is it likely to have an impact on land owned by a person other than the land owner as the impacts to the land during construction will be temporary and the mitigation and re-instatement measures to be implemented will ensure that the productive capacity of the land will be returned to pre-construction condition.
