Approved resource activities

The approved resource activity: petroleum and gas and area of surface disturbance is set out in Table 1 below.

This development approval authorises impacts on the Channel Country Strategic Environmental Area – designated precinct by the approved resource activity.

Resource activity	Definition
Buried flowline	5.5 km buried flowline, within a 15m wide right of way, including clearing and grading of the route, transporting and laying out piping sections, trenching and padding, stringing, laying and welding pipe within trench and backfilling of trench. The flowline will include two mid-line risers and pigging facilities. The pigging facilities will be co-located on the well pads.

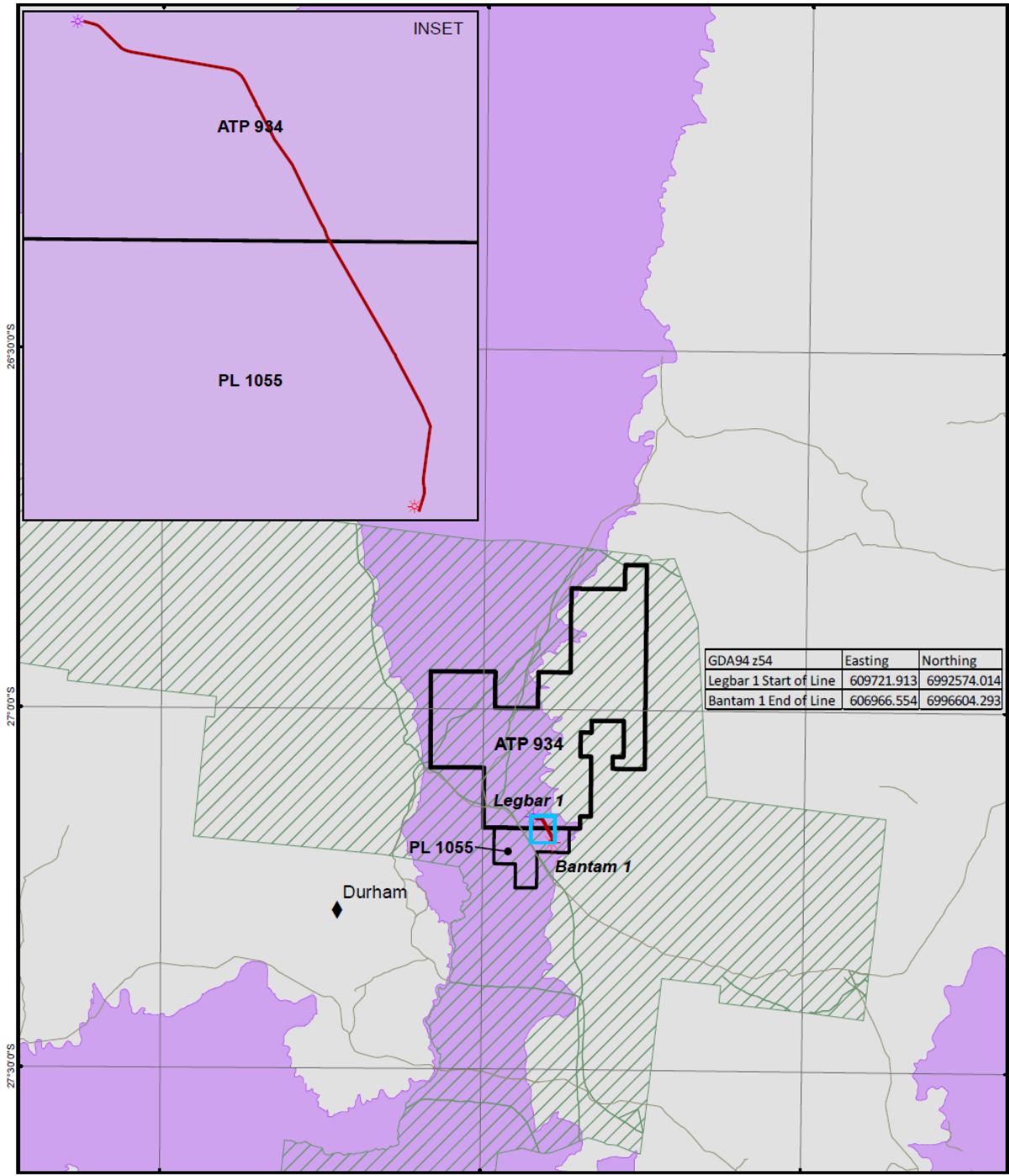

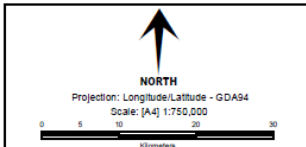
General Advice
