## Purpose of application form

This form is to be used when making an assessment application for a regional interests development approval (RIDA) under the *Regional Planning Interests Act 2014* (RPI Act).

#### **Definitions**

Expressions highlighted in bold italic type have the same meaning as in the RPI Act or in regulations made under the RPI Act.

#### How to make the Assessment Application

Section 29 of the RPI Act provides:

An assessment application must be-

- i. made to the chief executive in the approved form; and
- ii. accompanied by a report—
- iii. assessing the resource activity or regulated activity's impact on the area of regional interest; and
- iv. identifying any constraints on the configuration or operation of the activity; and
- v. accompanied by the fee prescribed under a regulation.

The applicant must complete all sections of the form unless otherwise expressly provided in the form. If the space provided on the form is insufficient, please provide the information as an attachment.
