Gathering	Construction, commissioning and operation of approximately 10m
pipelines	of buried HDPE gathering pipelines that allows for the transfer of both gas and water within a 30m wide Right of Way (RoW). Carry out regular inspections of the condition of the RoW and signage. Carry out maintenance as required. Monitor restoration activities as required.
