Gas pipeline	A high pressure steel gas pipeline 450mm in diameter between the APLNG Reedy Creek Gas Processing Facility and the APA Wallumbilla Gas Hub (Petroleum Pipeline Licence PPL2023), over a distance of 49km. The pipeline will be buried to a minimum depth of 900mm (measured at the top of the pipeline) and will be located within a right of way of up to 30m. Extra work space will be required to construct the pipeline.

This development approval authorises impacts on a Strategic Cropping Area (SCA) by the approved activities.
